2017 Grant

Marilyn Heinemann reported that the past year's focus has been to get new students. Clubs used the internet and other tools to get new students. Direction the next year is to provide dances for the new dancers. New dancers get out there and dance but become frustrated. Grant is for clubs to hold a Mainstream or Club 50 dance. It can be a regular dance night just at the Mainstream/Club 50 level. Delegates are to take this back to their club to ask if their club is willing to host a Mainstream/Club 50 Dance. Copy of application and program was available. First deadline is June 1st. Send information on dance after the dance. There are funds for up to two dances. Not valid for MCASD New Dancers Dance. It needs to be noted as a Mainstream/Dance. The purpose is to get experienced dancers to come out and dance with new dancers to help them. Regular dance format for those who have rounds; Rounds and Mainstream/Club 50. Stealing and Retrieving is allowed as these are regular dances. Students (non-

members) are not eligible for stealing/retrieve. Forms are on Shutterfly site which you can get to from Square Dance Chicago.

Caller School

New initiative this year. First class was in early April. Tom Miller spend 3 days teaching 10 dancers most with no calling experience. By the time finished on Sunday, they did basic patten and singing. A workshop was done Apr 22. Jack Pladdy's spend an afternoon workshop for 6 new callers.
